3 day plan

All classes will have an emergency 3 day plan that children can access straight away, independently in immediate closure or lockdown & while schools contingency plan for whatever circumstances arise.



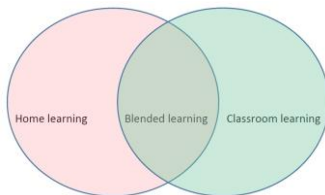
Core learning

All classes will have an overview & lessons for very important core learning that children should re-visit. This will be available in a file with some hard copies of learning to support. Repeating learning and retrieval practice is a very important part of remembering.



Timetable

All classes will have timetable of teacher led and independent learning. Learning at home isn't optional and all best endeavours & partnership working must keep children on track. Children must register with teachers every day. Teachers are available to learners from 9-3.pm



Blended Learning

The blended approach can incorporate a variety of approaches – teachers live streaming into classrooms LSAs supervising – children logging into classrooms from home – everyone logging in from home! Complex but doable. Where there is a will there is a way!



ZIP IT
Keep your personal stuff private and think about what you say and do online.



BLOCK IT
Block people who send nasty messages and don't open unknown links and attachments.



FLAG IT
Flag up with someone you trust if anything upsets you or if someone asks to meet you offline.

E-safety

Safeguarding is everyone's concern & a key priority. Staff monitor chat and online activity, children must report concerns immediately and parents must supervise online learning activity.
